

Notice concerning the Lesson Arrangement after the Special Holidays, F.1 After-School Homework Guidance Class, the Details concerning the COVID-19 Vaccination and its Related Scheme

Please note the following:

**1. The Lesson Arrangement after the Special Holidays**

According to the guidelines issued by the EDB, the lessons dated from 19<sup>th</sup> April (Tuesday) to 29<sup>th</sup> April are arranged as follows:

\*The original arrangements of afternoon supplementary online lessons, homework guidance classes and F.5 M1 remain unchanged (Please refer to the notice 2021-24 issued on 29<sup>th</sup> January)

Face-to-face lessons will be resumed in stages in May based on the Education Bureau’s guidelines. Please pay attention to the school announcements made later. When the aforesaid face-to-face lessons are resumed in May, students have to complete the COVID-19 rapid antigen test (RAT) before going to school on every school day. The test has to be conducted in the morning, and only students with a negative result is allowed to attend school. For students with a positive result, they need to report [the result] to the school immediately and stay at home. At the same time, they also need to report it to the Department of Health (DH) through the ‘Declaration System for Individuals Tested Positive for COVID-19 Using Rapid Antigen Test’ platform (<https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp/>). Both the EDB and the school have contingency measures to help the students who have difficulties. Details will be announced later.

**2. F. 1 After-school Homework Guidance Classes**

The aim of these classes is to let the students complete their homework under the guidance of teachers, so their learning can be consolidated. During the lessons, the students may ask the teachers when questions or difficulties arises. Due to the epidemic, the aforesaid classes will temporarily be conducted online using Microsoft Teams. Please refer to the table below for the lessons from 19<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> April:
